

## Admission of international patients (Foreign nationals)



## Necessary documents:

- \*passport of the country of origin
- \*Hospitalization order of the referring physician if any
- \* Medical documents
- \*Authentic confirmation of the person not suffering from IHR infectious diseases
- \*Health tourism insurance

Reference the patient to the clinic or emergency ward and checking the documents by the receptionist

Informing the IPD expert by the receptionist and security guards

The IPD expert goes to the inpatient admission to getting a copy of the passport and accompanying the patient, to visit and determine the patient's assignment by the IPD physician in the emergency department.

No Does the patient need hospitalization?

Registration of demographic and clinical information and filing patient's hospitalization file and completion of the admission process by the receptionist

Obtaining informed consent from the patient or her legal guardian by the receptionist in cooperation with the IPD nurse

Referring the patient to the outpatient service unit and receiving services

Completion of the form for foreign nationals in three sheets to be submitted to statistics, security and international units

Coordinating with the inpatient department and delivering the patient file to the ward nurse

Welcome and introduction of the department to the patient by the IPD expert

Providing training to the patient upon arrival by the IPD nurse

Start the treatment process by the physician
